

Child Care can be *Costly!*



We can help you pay for it!

The Illinois Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) makes it possible for families and guardians who qualify to receive financial help. The program pays for child care costs so you can work, attend training or school.

Families have the power to choose the child care option that works best for them:

Child Care Center

Care provided in a group setting.

Family Child Care Home

Care provided in the home of a licensed provider or family, friend, or neighbor's home.

In-Home Child Care

Care provided in the home of the child by a family, friend, or neighbor.

Use this chart to see if your family might be eligible.
