

EIU students in CDS are eligible to apply for ISAC Special Education Teacher Tuition Waiver

Students who are Illinois residents, attend public Illinois universities such as EASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY, and plan to work in the school setting in Illinois as a speech pathologist or other special education teacher after graduation, are eligible to apply for ISAC's Illinois Special Education Tuition Waiver

- ◇ The program that pays for tuition and mandatory fees for up to four calendar years in exchange for working in an Illinois school (public, private, non-profit, parochial) for 2 of 5 years after graduating
- ◇ Website is in picture below (isac.org) or search "Illinois Special Education Tuition Waiver"
- ◇ The application is typically available on the website in mid-December and must be submitted before March 1st
- ◇ Each year, ISAC awards 250 of these Special Ed tuition and fee waiver scholarships. If you are not selected by the July notification, apply again next year. The scholarship is good for up to 4 years, and can be used in grad school too. (All information obtained from www.isac.org)
