The EIU Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic and the Communication Disorders & Sciences academic department are located on the second floor of the Human Services Center, south 7th Street on EIU's campus.

- Enter Charleston on Route 16 (Lincoln Street)
- Turn south on either 4th Street or 9th Street (7th Street is not a through street)
- Proceed to Roosevelt Street; turn right from 9th Street or left from 4th Street
- Proceed to the first stop sign which will be at the intersection of 7th Street; turn north
