- _____ Successfully complete the Economics Program with at least a 2.0 GPA for ECN coursework.
- _____ Successfully complete a minimum of 12 semester hours in residence in courses applicable to GPA in Economics.
- _____ Successfully complete 40 semester hours in upper division (3000-4000) courses.
- _____ Successfully complete 42 semester hours in residence (minimum of 32 hours in junior and senior years, 12 of which must be in residence senior year).
- _____ Successfully complete 120 semester hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- _____ Foreign language requirement (2 years HS w/ C or better, or 2 courses at the collegiate level – single language).
- _____ Successfully complete the Electronic Writing Portfolio (3 EWP appropriate submissions).
- _____ Language requirement (C or better in each ENG 1001G, ENG 1002G, and CMN 1310G or accepted substitutes).
- _____ A transfer student must successfully complete a minimum of 56 semester hours applicable to a BA in senior institutions, with at least 42 hours at EIU.
