<u>Rationale for Change</u>: In reviewing the 2013-14 catalog, we discovered that the incorrect course number and course title was inserted for Elementary Middle School Option students in the course options listed for English Literature. It lists ENG 4906-Problems in Teaching English instead of ENG 4905-Studies in Youth Literature. This request does not result in any program change.
