

2018-2019 VERIFICATION OF STUDENT ILLINOIS RESIDENCY (FOR INDEPENDENT STUDENT)

In order for an independent student to be eligible for the Monetary Award Program (MAP), the student must be a resident of the State of Illinois. It is this office's responsibility to ensure that all MAP recipients meet this requirement set forth by the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC). For an independent student to be considered an Illinois resident for MAP purposes, s/he must have: **physically resided in Illinois (at the time of application), and also resided for 12 continuous full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year for which assistance is requested and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home.** Students who are in a graduate or post-baccalaureate program are not eligible for MAP. *Failure to complete this form will delay the processing of your aid.*
