I am requesting under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140, the following documents:

- An account of where all funds for tuition financial aid came from in the academic years 2011-2012, and 2012-2013.

An An account of where tuition is allocated on a per student basis for the academic years 2011-2012, and 2012-2013.

I understand that the Act permits a public body to charge a reasonable copying fee not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction and not including the costs of any search or review of the records. 5 ILCS 140/6

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information to me is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government and is not primarily in my commercial interest. I write newspaper articles that appears in newspapers across the state. The requested information will contribute to my journalism endeavors. Please keep my request within the boundaries of a free service (50 pages, 8 hours) in the event that my request incurs a charge.

I am requesting these documents in electronic format.
