Rock Me Amadeus: The Genius Seminar (*CRN 99584*) **C. England 1-1:50 W PEMB 1160** What is genius and where does creative inspiration come from? These are the two big questions at the heart of a seminar that opens with a reading of Peter Shaeffer's *Amadeus*. Students can expect to do some literary and film criticism and to examine some influential nonfiction accounts of the nature of inspiration. Along the way we will ask how ordinary mortals might extend their own creative capacities and experience more inspired thinking.

What should we believe? Are there reasonably generalizable criteria to help us answer this question? Are there beliefs or ways of thinking which are immoral? In this seminar we will explore philosophy, law, science and media theories as we explore how we use evidence and how we should use it in addressing complex questions and controversies.
