

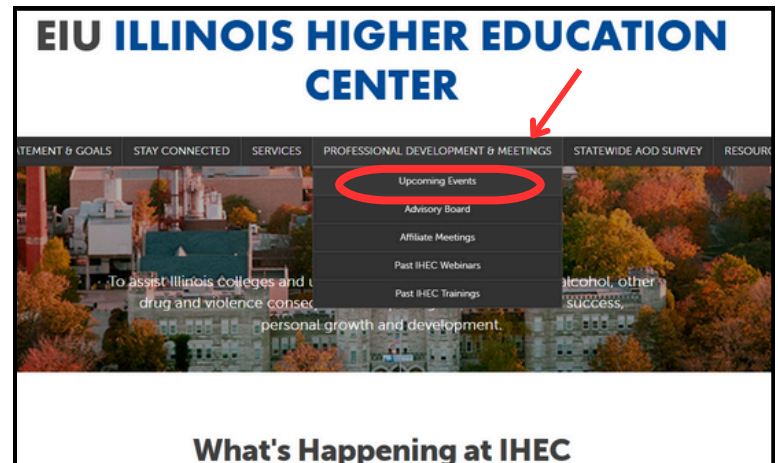
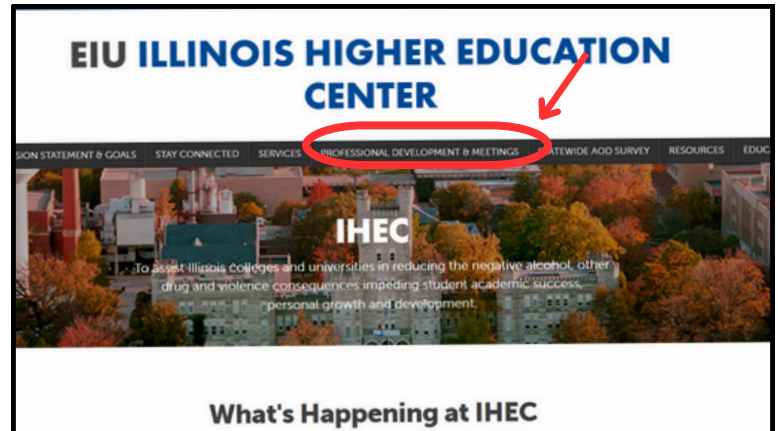
LIQUID COURAGE: THE ROLE OF ALCOHOL IN HAZING
