



- Earn 6 credits
- No German Language Skills Required
- Our Guiding Study Question: How did Germany transform itself within half a century from a racial, genocidal state under Nazism into the largest liberal democratic state in Europe? How did Berlin and Munich--capitals of the Nazi movement and Nazi regime--"come to terms" with their Nazi past?
- Explore: Germany's Landscape of collective memory in and around Berlin, Munich, Dresden, Nuremberg, and Berchtesgaden. What is remembered, memorialized, or forgotten?

- **Experience:** Life in what are Germany's most populous, pulsing, and vibrant cities. Find your favorite hip district, beer garden, or market.
