## MBA 5680, Organizational Behavior and Group Dynamics

Course Description: Organizational and business application of theory and research in individual differences, interpersonal relations, and small group dynamics. *Prerequisites: BUS 3010 and admission to the MBA or MSNS-GIS degree program.* 

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Analyze key challenges and emerging trends in management related to the impact on productivity and performance of employees.
- 2. Diagnose causes of organizational problems and formulate alternatives based on judgment and experience to address those problems.
- 3. Proactively organize for effective interactions.
- 4. Anticipate employee attitudes and behaviors, suggest alternative managerial practices, and explain responses when managing employees individually, in groups, and as a collective part of an organization.
- 5. Explain the complexity of managerial decision-making in bridging different stakeholder needs.
- 6. Explain and compare self and others' managerial styles, philosophies, and communication strengths and weaknesses.
