Only required music ensembles at the 02XX course level may count towards graduation.

In order to graduate with an option in performance, students must earn a "C" or better in all music courses except those that are taken as electives. A failed music course may be repeated once to receive a passing grade as required by the degree program.

Permission for a third attempt to pass the course may be granted upon approval of the instructor, advisor, and the department chair.
