April 21, 2021 (Zoom)

- II. Updates on Outreach Events
 1. CEVO- Jenny was going to reach out to CEVO to see how this event turned out. The event ends 4-23-21.
 2. SACIS Tabling- went well, particularly SACIS on the steps
 3. Sex is like Pizza- good turn out. 10 at the live and several that have viewed it since.
 4. Forum- 20 in attendance. Shawn shared that having it in-person may have helped increase audience numbers. Lindsay shared that having it virtual, allowing attendees to have their camera off, may increase comfort in asking questions that may otherwise be difficult to ask in person.

- III. Tic Toc- video/posts going around for a “national rape day” on April 24th. This was shared to make members aware and discussed if and/or how to respond. Brittany shared that there is an email thread that includes SA offices from other institutions; some institutions are choosing, at this time, to not address or respond as they are not wanting to call further attention to this in a negative way. Some institutions are having their UPD offices post a response on their webpage. Members expressed concern with responding, not wanting to call further attention to it in a negative way. Heather expressed concern that it may fill people’s newsfeeds with similar content if they go looking for it, because of the way Tic Toc (and other social media outlets) work/function. Members discussed how much discussion seems to be happening about it or how well known is it with our students. Members expressed that they’d heard little to no information on it, outside of this meeting.
