

Sexual Violence Prevention Team
Meeting Minutes
September 16, 2016

- I. In attendance: Lindsay Wilson (counseling center), Shawn Peoples (OCR), Amanda Harvey (HERC), Courtney Carver (HERC/Counseling Center), Jody Stone (Housing), Dena Kniess (CSD), Colton Janes (FSP), Jeannie Ludlow (WST), Erin Walters (SACIS), Amanda Feder (SACIS), Catie Witt (SBG), Dr. Heather Webb (Student Standards), Kent Martin (UPD), and Kimberlie Mook (NSFP & MSAC).
- II. Awareness Week in the Fall: September 26th-30th
 1. Take back the Day 5k- September 24th Sister City Park. Erin shared that they have been meeting with student groups. Groups will automatically get a group rate of 5 students at \$25. One fraternity completed a \$100 sponsorship. She explained that while they will be offered the benefits of a business sponsorship, this will be viewed as 4 student group nominations, allowing this fraternity more student registrations. She also shared that some athletic teams are involved in volunteer work.
 2. Voices of Empowerment Event: September 26th at 7pm at 7th St. Underground. Erin reports 5-6 committed performers and many others who are contacting SACIS with interest. Performers must be screened by SACIS first.
 3. Night of HOPE: September 30th 5-9 open house at Jackson Coffee House.
 4. Silent Outreach Efforts on Campus. Informational Flyers/Handouts and Tabling events will be pushed that week.
 5. Offering/Encouraging Consent Sessions throughout the semester (this week as well)
- III. It's on Us- Catie shared many ideas for this campaign.
 1. Committee-Student Senate will make up part of the committee but other students' involvement will be important. Hope to get this committee started within the next week.
 2. Ideas include: Campaign video including faculty/staff and some higher administration to show their investment in this issue. The dodge ball tourney was rather popular last year so thoughts of bringing it back were discussed. One reason this may have been popular is because of the competitive nature. The idea to have a scavenger hunt, allowing students to become more aware of some offices involved with Sexual Assault Awareness and Response, and allowing them to visit some of these offices, may be fun.
 3. Catie expressed interest in surveying EIU's understanding of Sexual Assault. She shared of a survey she'd read about, conducted years ago on a college campus, that showed the misperceptions of sexual assault at that time.
 4. Colton Janes, shared that many students have expressed pleasure in being involved previously and continued interest in involvement. He shared that PanHellenic had interest in showing the documentary Hunting Grounds, but had questions on obtaining it. He was recommended to call Booth Library.
- IV. Shawn Peoples shared that sorority Delta Sigma Theta holds an event in Oct called the "Night of Expression," in support and awareness to domestic violence.
- V. Haven- When it is ready there will be an email sent by OCR. This is expected early this week (9/19/16). Even if not required, all EIU staff and faculty are encouraged to complete this training!
- VI. Homegrown- An informational page was created and will be put into PAWS. All students will have to sign off that they have completed the training. Paws allows for tracking when it is completed by each student. Some of the information included is: definition of consent, amnesty, reporting options, confidential reporting, and available survivor services.

- VII. Addition to the Consent Presentation. Sex is like Pizza Presentation is being developed. Is the use of another metaphor/analogy. Gets audience more involved and engaged. Pizza is used to model communication and then compared to communication within sex and/or sexual relationships.
